RACE COMMITTEE GOALS

- Offer fair competition to all skippers
- Give competitors a good start line, course, and a finish line
- Starts on time, gives clear racing instructions, and signals, sets a precise course and adjusts promptly to changing wind conditions



THE TEAM

- Principal Race Officer (in charge)
- Crew duties
 - Time keeper
 - Recorder
 - Flags and sounds
 - Line judge



RACE DAY COMPONENTS

- Preparation
- Setting marks
- The start
- During the race
- The finish



RACE DAY PREPARATION

- Weather check
- Ground tackle check
- Marks inflated
- Clocks and watches checked
- Flag inventory
- Check-in sheet, recording sheets, pencils
- White board and lettering
- Check radio on Race Committee Channel

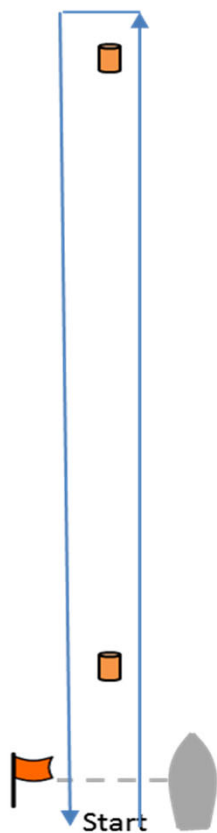


SETTING MARKS

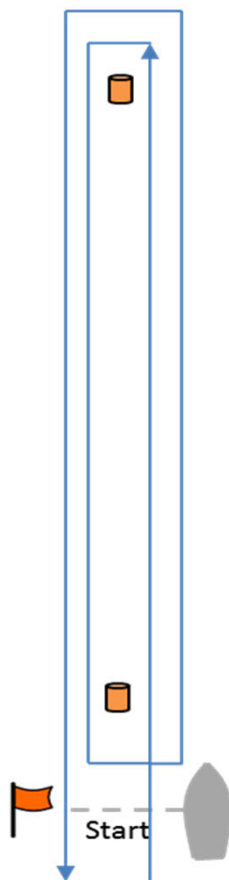
- Attach all lines to marks and anchors
 - Mark – chain – line – chain – mark
- Drop pin mark first, pay out line and then drop remaining chain and anchor.
 - Check to see if mark is set or dragging
- Set anchor for signal boat. Increase scope to make the line square and 1.5x aggregate boat length



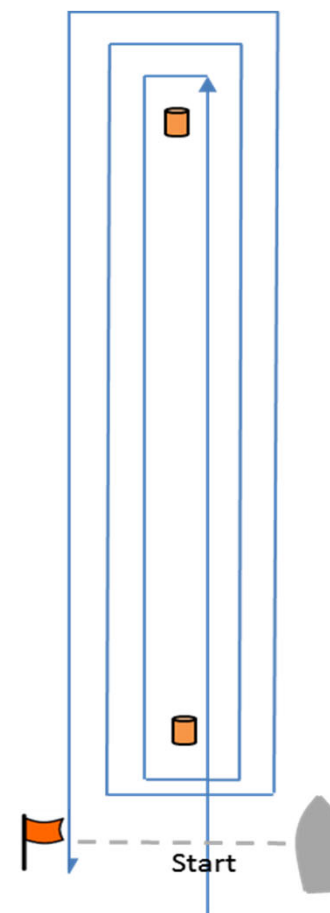

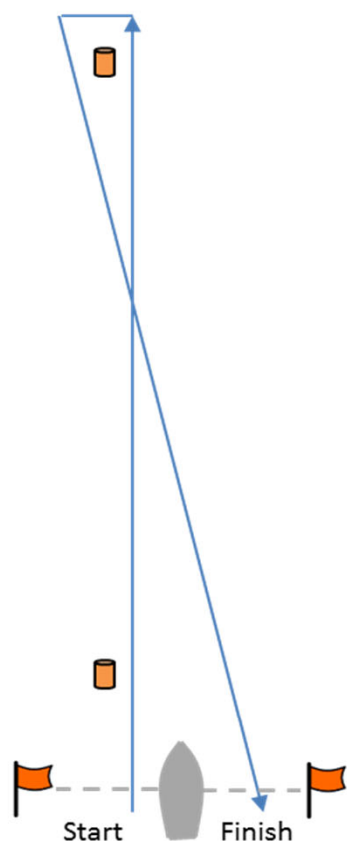

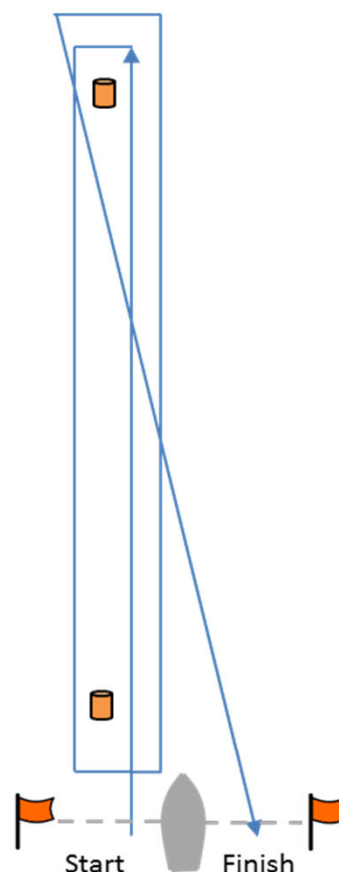

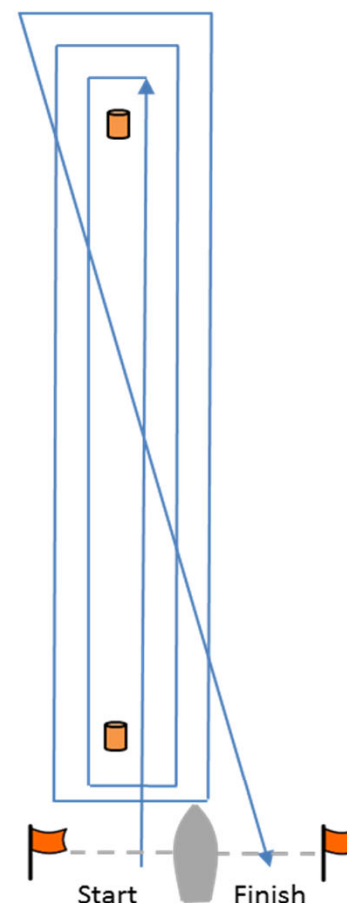
THE RACE COURSE – MULTI FLEET

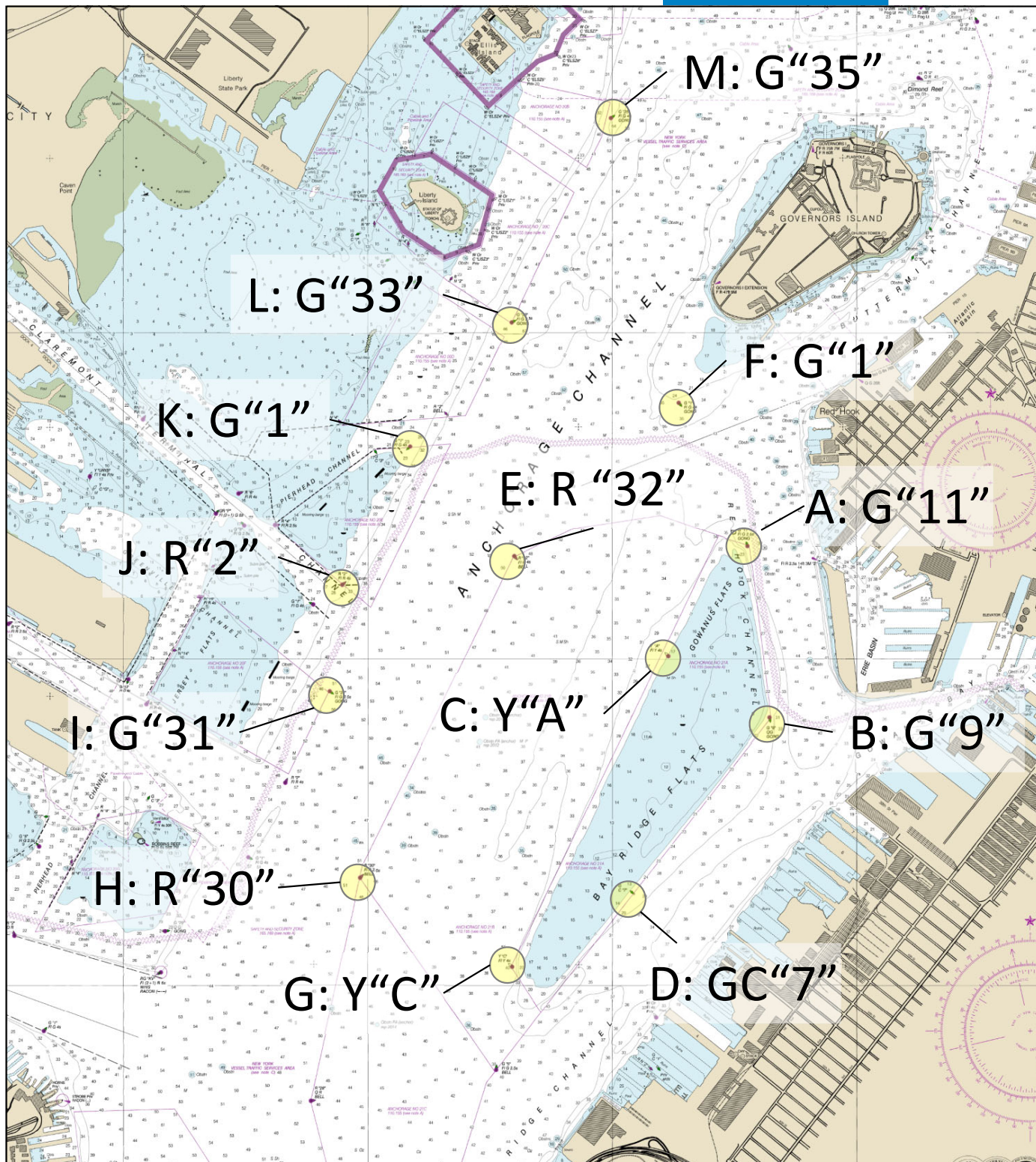

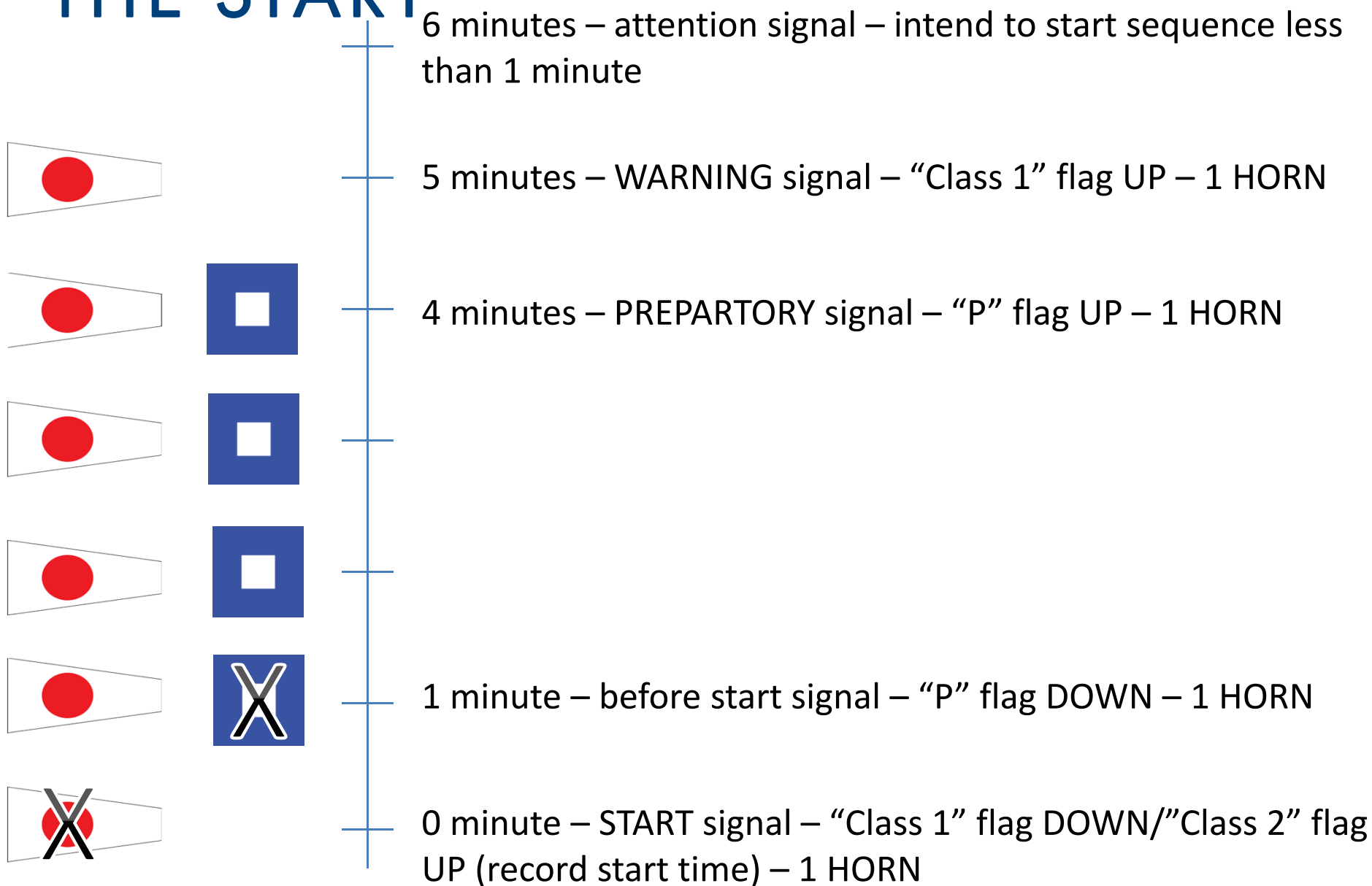

PRE-START CHECK

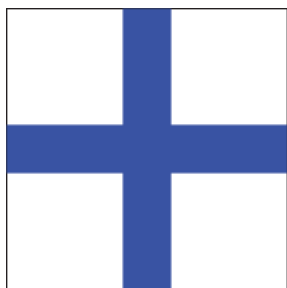
- Record all boats checking in
- Review starting procedure with all crew
- Line flag set (orange)
- Flags on poles
 - "AP"
 - "Class flag"
 - "P"
 - "X" and "1st Substitute"
- Timer, horn and VHF check

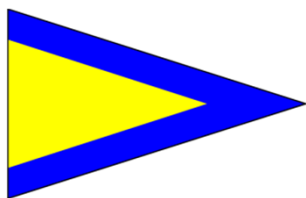

Individual Recall

"X" UP - 1 HORN

"X" flag DOWN – 1 HORN earlier of restarting and 4 minutes



General Recall

"First Substitute" UP - 2 HORNS

"First Substitute" DOWN - 1 HORN



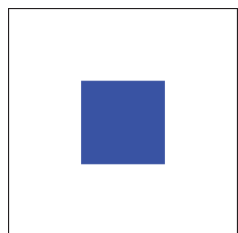
DURING THE RACE



Course change

“C” Flag UP with repeated HORNS

With red/green or +/-



Shorten course to finish

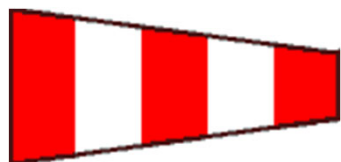
“S” Flag with repeated HORNS

Finish at line flag at end of leg



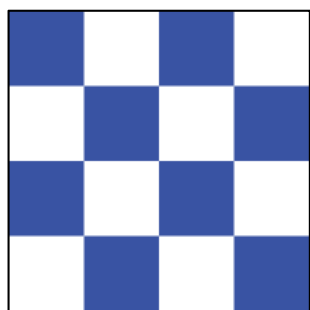
WHEN THINGS GO WRONG

Before the start (postpone)



"AP" UP with 2 HORNS

"AP" DOWN with 1 HORN – 1 minute to
WARNING



After the start (abandon)

"N" UP with 3 HORNS

"N" DOWN with 1 HORNS – 1 minute to
WARNING



FINISH CHECK

- Record time of first and last finishers
- Record all boats finishing
- Record any protest flags

- Fly "YELLOW" flag to indicate another race to follow
