

# 2022 Women's Regatta

# **NOTICE OF RACE**

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The organizing authority is the ONE°15 Brooklyn Sail Club
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 ("RRS"), and the spirit of the class rules for the J/80
- 1.3. The following RRS are changed:
  - RRS 44.1 is changed as follows:
    The first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn
    Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an
    incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of
    Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall
    be a Two-Turns Penalty.'
  - b) RRS 40 is changed as follows:'USCG approved personal flotation devices (PFD) shall be worn at all times'
- 1.4. Under RRS 87, rules of the J80 class are changed as follows:

J/80:

- 1. Section B.1 is deleted (Class Association Sticker)
- 2. Section C is deleted (Conditions for Racing)
- 3. Section 5.3.1(i) is added as follows: "(The engine minimum weight shall not be less than 12.5kg (empty of fuel). When not in use, engine and any removable outboard bracket shall remain in place on the transom"
- 1.5. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules

## 2. ADVERTISING

2.1. No advertising on Club boats is allowed unless approved by the Director of Sailing Operations

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. This event is intended to give women the opportunity and confidence to do something new in a safe, fun and competitive environment to get more women helming and crewing on race boats regularly
- 3.2. The regatta is open to all Full Members. The objective to encourage all women members of the Sail Club to participate. The organizing authority will determine which boats will be used for this regatta.



- 3.3. Each team shall consist of at least four and no more than six women members. Teams shall be all women if there is an insufficient number of women members, The organizing authority will establish teams as required.
- 3.4. The helm of the boat for the team must be (i) a woman with racing skipper privileges or (ii) a woman Full Member who will be accompanied by a sponsor, Club Members (male or female) with racing skipper privileges (who retain full responsibility of the vessel).
- 3.5. Interested participants register here:
  - a) Skipper/women who want to helm a race boat
  - b) Crew/women who want to be on race boat
  - c) Sponsors race skippers willing to sponsor a team (male or female)
  - d) race committee volunteers (male or female)

3.6. The organizing authority will have final authority in allocating teams to boats

## 4. FEES

4.1. Entry fee is minimum \$120 per boat.

### 5. SCHEDULE AND VENUE

- 5.1. Races are scheduled for the Saturday, August 20th, 2022
- 5.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1330
- 5.3. Races may be held in conjunction with other ONE15 Brooklyn Sail Club events

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The sailing instructions will be available after August 19th, 2022 on the Sail Club's website

### 7. VENUE

7.1. The races will be held in the area South of Governor's Island near Gowanus Flats

## 8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. The courses to be sailed can be:
  - a) Windward-leeward courses
  - b) Around special marks set by the race committee
  - c) Around Government marks, or
  - d) Around a combination of Government marks and special marks



### 9. SCORING

- 9.1. The scoring system will be the Low Point System of Appendix A of the RRS, as modified by the sailing instructions
- 9.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta

### 10. PRIZES

10.1. Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.

### 11. POST RACE EVENTS

11.1. After event festivities will be at Estuary Restaurant.

### 12. CHANGES

12.1. Changes to the Notice of Race will be posted on the website. http://one15brooklynmarina.com/club-home/
